## TROOP 191 10/10 WEST POINT FOOTBALL WHAT-TO-BRING & GAME DAY TIMELINE

### WHAT TO BRING Most importantly: Tickets, this itinerary, and the attached map

- Warm clothing (The stadium is notoriously Klondike-Derby-Cold)
- Rain gear, including rain pants. BE PREPARED. No umbrellas. (You can't bring them in the stadium)
- Money for snacks and souvenirs. Please try to get your ATKDA Tailgate wristbands IN ADVANCE.
- (optional) A cushion to sit on during the game. Stadium benches are hard.
- (optional) Folding lawn chairs for the tailgate party. (Do not bring to stadium)
- DO NOT BRING KNIVES (You can't bring them in the stadium)

**All attendees can come/go to any event below as they please.**

7:30-8:30am TROOP 191 PRE-GAME TAILGATE PARTY (Optional) BUFFALO SOLDIER FIELD

Bring your own breakfast and coffee. Drop off your folding chairs for the post game tailgate party. Take a shuttle to the Cadet Review.

9:00-9:45am CADET REVIEW "The Plain" PARADE FIELD

One of the time honored traditions of a West Point game day, a full-dress cadet parade takes place on "The Plain" three hours prior to kickoff (weather permitting) for every home game. If cadet review is cancelled due to weather, ASK ANY CADET FOR TOUR INFORMATION.

10:00am GROUP TOURS Depart from TBD; ask any cadet (rain or shine)

Cadets will be leading small groups for tours. For those not taking a tour, take a shuttle to the stadium.

10-11:30am Black Knights Alley Fan Festival MICHIE STADIUM

At 10am the gates open along with everything else that Michie Stadium has to offer, including the concessions and merchandise stands. TRY TO GET TO YOUR SEATS BY 11:30am.

11:40am Band Takes Field/Cadet March-On/National Anthem MICHIE STADIUM

Once the 1,000 Cadets are in position on the field, a member of the Cadet Glee Club and the Army Band perform the National Anthem

11:50am Parachute Demonstration MICHIE STADIUM

A fan favorite portion of the game, look skyward as you see West Point cadets jump from a helicopter and land on the field as they parachute in the official game ball and flags approximately 10 minutes before kickoff.

11:58am Army Team Takes the Field for NOON KICKOFF MICHIE STADIUM

The Black Knights are led out of the tunnel by the Army Rabble Rousers, mascots, American flag, and a flag representing that week's unit patch that is being worn on the jerseys. Note all scouts, including Mr. Kimmick, are encouraged to join the first-year cadets in doing push-ups for every point Army scores during the game.

AFTER THE GAME ATKDA POST-GAME TAILGATE PARTY BUFFALO SOLDIER FIELD (BSF)

We will be having a tailgate party full of activities after the game, RAIN or SHINE. Look for the ATKDA banner directly across from Thayer Hotel. YOU CAN WALK to BSF from Michie stadium right down MILLS ROAD.

- MENU: Hot Dogs, Hot Dog Rolls, Tofu Dogs, Baked Beans, Pretzels, Ketchup, Mustard, Sauerkraut, Birch Beer, Lemonade, Water. Adults are responsible for any other beverages they would like to bring.
  - COST: \$6 per kids/\$12 per adult: Please buy wristbands in advance. You can sponsor cadets in advance or on game day by buying adult wristband and giving it to the cadet of your choice.

**PARKING PASSES** Follow Shuttle Route based on Parking Lot.

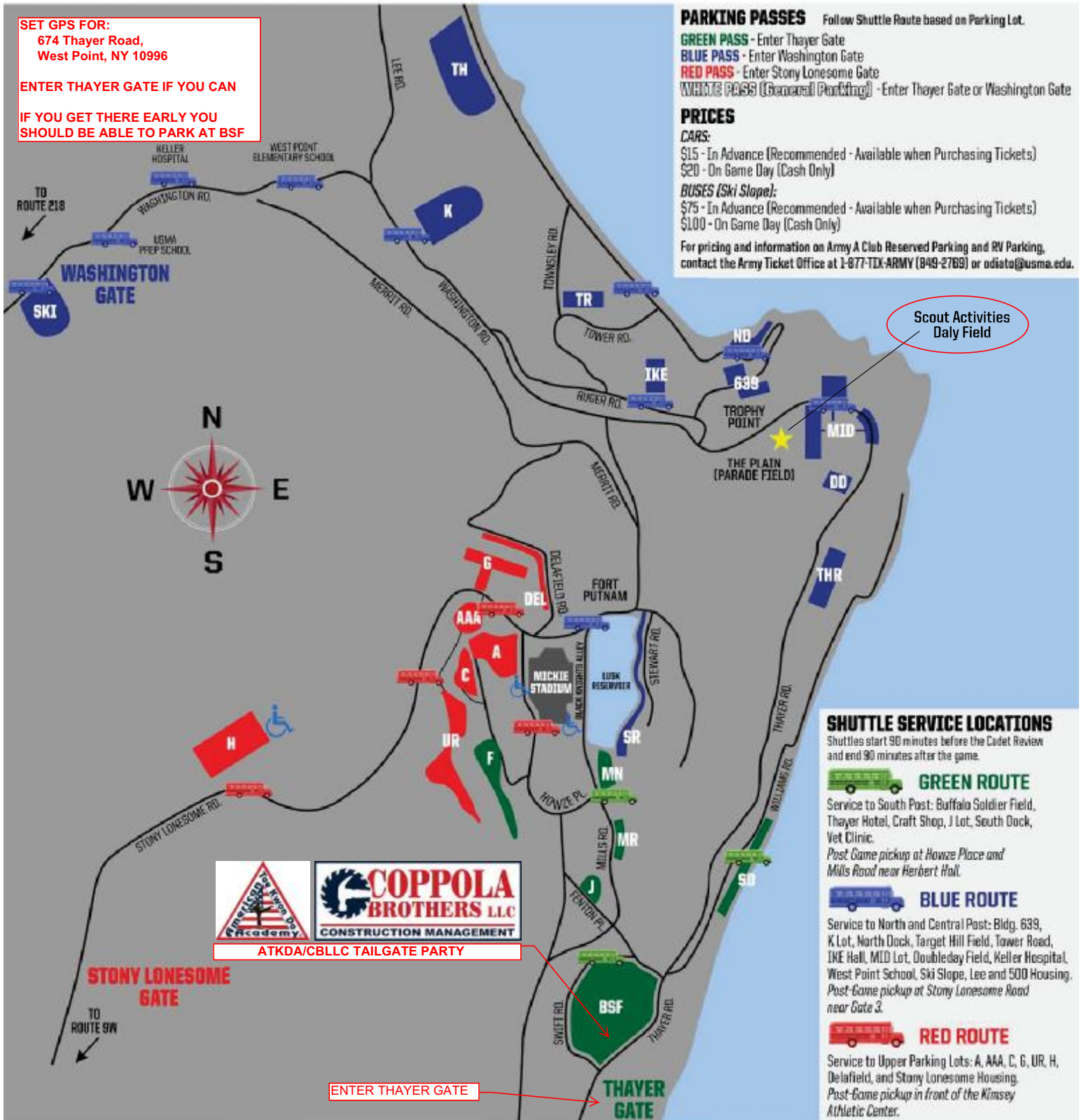
**GREEN PASS** - Enter Thayer Gate
